# **NOTICE OF RACE**

### **1 RULES**

- 1.1** The event is governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules Of Sailing*.
- 1.2** The SA Sailing prescriptions for National and Regional Championships will apply.

### **2 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

The sailing instructions will be posted on the Hunter Class Website no later than 18H00 on the 21<sup>st</sup> of January 2024 and will be available at registration.

### **3 COMMUNICATION**

- 3.1** The online official notice board is located on the official Hunter Class Website

### **4 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY**

- 4.1** The regatta is open to all boats of the Hunter19 Class that meet class association requirements.
- 4.2** Eligible boats may enter by completing the entry form and submitting it, together with the fee, by 21<sup>st</sup> February 2024, registering online using Google Forms.

- 4.4** Please email your Proof of Payment to [jessica@jlenz.co.za](mailto:jessica@jlenz.co.za) upon completion, with your reference being skippers first name initial, full surname and sail number eg. J.Doe SA157
- 4.5** To be considered an entry in the event, a boat shall complete all registration requirements and pay all fees.
- 4.6** Late entries will be accepted after 21<sup>st</sup> February under the following conditions: Late entry fee is an additional R250.
- 4.7** All competitors shall be members in good standing of SA Sailing and of a yacht club affiliated to and in good standing with SA Sailing (or their equivalent in the case of non-South Africans) and legally permitted to compete.
- 4.8** Proof of such membership shall be presented at registration.

## **6 ADVERTISING**

[DP] Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organising authority.

## **7 SCHEDULE**

**7.1** Registration: 21 March 2024, from 07H30 to 10H30.

**7.2** Equipment inspection and event measurement: 21 March 2024 from 07H30 to 11H00 and /or by prior arrangement as determined by the Class Association.

**7.3** Dates of racing:

Sat 21 March 2024, Sunday 22 March 2024, Monday 23 March 2024, Tuesday 24 March 2024.

The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race is:

12H30 Saturday 21 March 2024

10H00 Sunday 22 March 2024

10H00 Monday 23 March 2024

10H00 Tuesday 24 March 2024

**7.4** A maximum of 12 races are scheduled.

**7.5** On the last scheduled day of racing Tuesday 24 March 2023 no warning signal will be made after 12H30.

## **8 MEASUREMENT**

**8.1** Each boat shall produce a valid measurement certificate.

**8.2** Boats shall be available for equipment inspection from 07H30 to 11H00 21 March 2024

## **9 SUPPORT PERSON VESSELS**

**9.1** Support person vessels shall be marked with a white flag.

**10 PRIZES** Prizes will be given as follows:

**10.1** Gold Medal – 1st Overall in Gold Division  
Silver Medal – 2nd Overall in Gold Division  
Bronze Medal – 3rd in Gold Division

**10.2** Gold Medal – 1st Overall in Silver Division  
Silver Medal – 2nd Overall in Silver Division  
Bronze Medal – 3rd in Silver Division

**10.3** Gold Medal – 1st Youth Team  
Silver Medal – 2nd Youth Team

**10.4** Gold Medal – 1st Woman's Team

**10.5** Gold Medal – 1st Wife & Husband (Partner) Team.

## **11 RISK STATEMENT**

RRS 3 states: "The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue to race is hers alone." Competitors participate in this event entirely at their own risk. The organising authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury, or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

## **12 INSURANCE**

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third party liability insurance with a minimum cover of R1m per incident or the equivalent.
